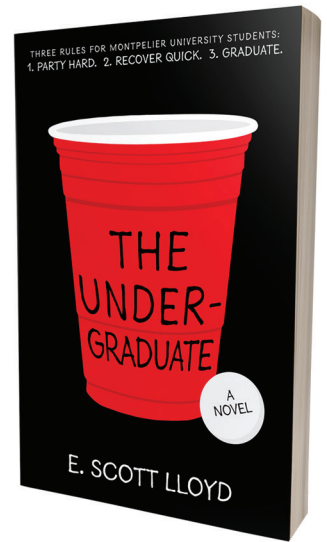


# The Undergraduate

### E. SCOTT LLOYD

As a Trump Administration official, Lloyd and his family endured a barrage of attacks from the radical left because he refused to use his office to procure abortions for immigrant teens. Lloyd became the target of Planned Parenthood, NARAL, the ACLU, and pro-abortion politicians. News outlets followed him to work and to church—and advocacy organizations took out full-page newspaper ads against him. NARAL Pro-Choice America explained its efforts: “We need to remove and publicly shame these anti-choice extremists one by one—and we’re starting with Lloyd.”

Lloyd returned to the private sector—by his own choice—in June 2019. No one could have predicted his next act: He is taking time to promote his first novel, *The Undergraduate*, a book attacked as a political manifesto in partisan media before its release. The book, however, is actually a work of fiction. In *The Undergraduate*, Lloyd has accomplished something authentic, unexpected, and notably devoid of the politics that made him a reluctant political celebrity.
