

Radio program shakes up Catholic media

"This is not pious background noise—it's Catholic radio that you'll want to share," says Fr. Robert McTeigue, S.J. "Catholics and other people of good will are hungry for the truth and conversations that feed that hunger. The Catholic Current is filling that need — and people are responding."

Father McTeigue hosts "The Catholic Current," now in its third year. Originating from The Station of the Cross Catholic Media Network. The show focuses on "bringing Christ to the world and the world to Christ" via intelligent conversation on the intersection of Catholicism and the news of the day.

"We're in challenging times, but that's no reason to retreat," the Jesuit priest explains. "We unpack what the world is selling and expose its emptiness by proclaiming all that is good, true, and beautiful — and we don't shy away from the difficult topics. I think our listeners really appreciate that."

The Catholic Current broadcasts live on the radio, the iCatholicRadio app, and TheStationOfTheCross.com, weekdays from 5-6 pm EST. The podcast is available on Apple Podcast and a variety of other platforms.
