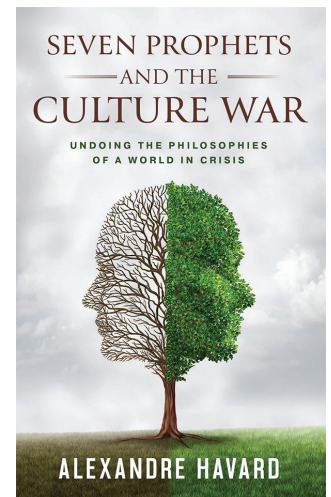
In his long-awaited new book, *Seven Prophets and the Culture War* (Scepter, 2024), Havard argues that philosophy undeniably influences every facet of our lives – from education to culture, politics, and interpersonal relationships. For better or for worse, philosophers’ ideas influence our hearts and minds.

“It is important to understand these ideas and to unravel them,” Havard writes in *Seven Prophets and the Culture War*, “to determine what is true about them and what is false, which ones elevate man and which ones debase him. But it is even more important to determine what manner of person is the philosopher who is speaking to us.”

To this end, Havard introduces us to seven influential philosophers, reviewing their lives and thoughts in detailed yet easy-to-understand profiles.

Three of the seven – Descartes, Rousseau, and Nietzsche – provoked or facilitated great upheavals, many of which indelibly marked the world we live in today.

The others – Pascal, Kierkegaard, Dostoyevsky, and Soloviev – predicted these upheavals and showed us how to overcome them. Havard walks us through the hills and valleys of modern history: the philosophical pitfalls embraced by the world and the transcendent values and virtues that will help us overcome them.



ALEXANDRE HAVARD is the founder of the Virtuous Leadership System. He was born and raised in Paris and is a graduate of one of France’s leading law schools (Paris Descartes University).
